VI. Old Business –

- RSC GUIDELINE FEEDBACK FROM POINT OF FREEDOM:

ABE B -

1. I would like to see a line in the guidelines on when the region would vote on an idea if a Consensus isn't reached. I suggest that we use 2/3 majority to accept an idea and if areas abstain that they are no longer considered in regions' conscience for that idea.
2. Also Under Election of Trusted Servants
Remove the line: "the administrative committee will break the tie."
My suggestion is we should pick the new candidate's name out of a box..

COLBY S. -

1. Require reporting back to Areas and Groups.
2. Remove special tie-breaking authority for the Administrative Committee.
3. Replace "cultivating leaders" with "developing trusted servants" in the mission statement.
Much of the lingo in these guidelines still reflect that regional service is superior to area and group service.
4. Clarify that all delegated authority originates from and remains accountable to the groups.

- Are there guidelines in place? Are there updates that point out the changes that have already been made?
- Gerald shared that this is an updated document. We are operating under these guidelines right now.
- There seems to a lot of confusion about where we are with these guidelines and how the region is operating moving forward with these changes. **The TASC needs more clarity on these guidelines.**
- Gerald is going to gather more information. **If the approval of these guidelines comes to a vote, we reject the guidelines as they currently stand,** pending the request for more information. We need the other TASC Groups to review these guidelines and get back to Gerald before the next RSC.
- The next RSC will be September 19 and 20th in the Fort Worth Area.
 - Restored to Sanity Group.
 - Saturday will be Workshops. Business starts at 10am on Sunday the 20th.

VII. New Business

- Gerald is proposing that we have a Service Slam covering our Service Structure and how communication flows between the different bodies.
 - Intent: Better understanding of how our Service Structure works
 - Supported by Tradition 1, Concept 1 and Step 12.

- If the TASC approves, what is your path forward?
 - Gerald suggests we create a subcommittee meeting.
 - The GSRs need to take this back to the Groups.
- Does the TASC want to host a Service Slam (Speaker Jam: Speakers sharing on NA Service) covering our Service Structure and how communication flows between the different bodies?

 - We don't have many expenses for our Area and the TASC is hosting this convention.
